

Each candidate had to produce satisfactory evidence of having had not less than five years practical experience in a mine; and the examination to be suitable for practical miners, and to be such as to ascertain the knowledge necessary for the practical working of mines in this district. In No. 1. --Arithmetic. Of the 52 who failed to pass, 45 having under this subject received two-thirds of the marks, and 19 the total number obtainable, is satisfactory. In No. 2. --The Act and Special Rules. Fifty-two failing, and twelve only receiving two-thirds of the marks, indicates that the questions were beyond their comprehension. The questions implied that each candidate had in his memory the substantial requirements, and could state the case without referring to the text or having something practically before him to recall the points to his recollection.
