In the substance of the book we have a nearly unique account of the works and words of Jesus, with the evangelists profound deductions. With the substance of the book the reader is apt to become quite familiar. He reads Johns Gospel, as he reads the synoptic Gospels, for the sacred story and the lessons that lie upon the surface. But the average reader is exceedingly apt to miss the object of the book. If we are not greatly mistaken, very few readers can tell offhand why John wrote the book at all. Yet Saint John is careful to state the object of his book. "These things are written, that ye may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye may have life through his name" (20:31); just as near the close of his First Epistle, he states the object of that little tract, "These things have...
