

Method. --There is a decided tendency to do away with general method, as such, and incorporate it in subject methods and educational psychology. The aim of the course is to offer the fundamental principles in the teaching process and their relation to the learning process. The most common topics are a study of the formal steps of the recitation, the problem of how to study and teaching how to study, the selection and arrangement of subject-matter, methods of securing interest, individual attention, elements of skill and drill, development, and appreciation. Lesson plans, observation, and demonstration are required. There is the same work in all schools, and the same course is given during regular session as during the summer. Average credit, 4 hours. Method Subjects. --This group embraces methods in almost the entire field of elementary and high-school subjects. Both suggestive and demonstrative method is offered in all summer courses along with the content matter. The most common courses are in reading, arithmetic, language, grammar, literature, history, geography, nature study, drawing, construction work, penmanship, story-telling and child literature, dramatization, elementary science, folk dancing and games, physiology and hygiene, geometry, and library.
